OUR PRAYERS:

This morning we plan to begin a series of messages focused on the neglected letters of the New Testament. We begin today by looking at Paul's letter to Philemon and hear God's call to shape our relationships by Christian love. We also anticipate celebrating the Lord's Supper this morning and remembering Christ's love for us. All who have professed Jesus as their Lord and Savior, who are members in good standing of a Bible-believing congregation and who desire to lead a godly life are invited to join us at the Lord's table. This evening we are privileged to host the annual worship service focused on the Cadet ministry in Orange City. We plan to focus on their theme from 2 Timothy 2:15: "Prepare Yourself." We welcome those from the First, Immanuel and Living Water congregations as they join us.

Next week: In the morning we anticipate continuing our series by looking at 2 John. In this letter there is a call to love. But we plan to raise the question: Is that all we need? In the evening we plan to begin a 4-part series of messages (the evenings of Jan. 29, Feb. 5, 19 and 26) entitled "Lessons from the Land." In this series we plan to look at God's relationship with his people as recorded in the Old Testament and consider what God is saying to us through it. We plan to begin by looking at Genesis 12 & 13 where God promises the land of Canaan to

Abram. Together we reflect on the question: "Why this land?" This series would work well for group study. If you put together a group and would like to have some study questions, please contact Pastor Dave.

Give thanks that the group that traveled to Israel was able to return safely. Pray that the experiences of this trip will not only 'inform' but will 'transform.' **Marnee Miedema** is undergoing treatments twice a day. Pray that these treatments are effective in fighting the infection. Continue to pray for **Nancy Statema** as she receives maintenance treatments.
